Abstract

Traditionally, the Quebec dairy industry has always been protected under the law - guaranteeing a stable income to milk producers by restricting the production of milk to meet domestic demands, setting prices, and limiting imports. The present Article discusses the impact of free trade agreements, specifically, NAFTA 2.0 on this industry - as it threatens the supply management system on which Quebec dairy farmers depend for their livelihood because the United States and other trading partners demand access to the Canadian dairy market in exchange for access to their markets by Canadian manufacturers and service providers.
